FOTWF TO HONOR RETURNING VETS AND THEIR FAMILIES

The Families of The Wounded Fund, Inc. (FOTWF) will hold its Tenth Annual Dinner and Reception honoring combat-wounded service members and their families on Saturday, June 15, 2019 at the National Museum of the Marine Corps in Triangle, Virginia.

Jan C. Scruggs, Founder of the Vietnam Veterans Memorial in Washington, D.C., will keynote the Fund's tenth annual event at the Museum ([his biography here](#)).

FOTWF supports families of combat-wounded soldiers, Marines, sailors and airmen returning from the Global War on Terrorism. Wounded service members and their families who received assistance from the Fund will be honored at the dinner.

The all-volunteer, 501 (c) (3) charity directs 100% of its donations and the net proceeds from its events to assist families who come from all parts of the nation for treatment and rehabilitation at VA facilities including the Hunter Holmes McGuire VA Medical Center, Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, and Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. FOTWF has provided more than 700 cash grants to families since its founding in 2005.

FOTWF has no paid staff and receives generous administrative support from First Citizens Bank in Richmond and Fredericksburg, Virginia. The invitation-only event is underwritten by corporate sponsors who wish to show their support for these veterans and their families.
