Since 2005, Families of the Wounded Fund has provided generous financial assistance, as well as emotional support and practical information, to those families and caregivers who are at the bedsides of their severely wounded loved ones. Doctors say that the presence of a loved one dramatically improves their recovery and contributes greatly to the healing process.

WE HELP THE FAMILIES OF ALL SERVICE BRANCH MEMBERS, FROM ALL 50 STATES.

Our community-based mission is focused at the Richmond VA Medical Center, Fort Belvoir Community Hospital, Naval Medical Center Portsmouth, Hampton VA Medical Center, and Walter Reed National Military Medical Center. However, the impact is felt across the entire nation by military families representing all branches of the service. Family caregivers often travel far from home and stay for weeks and frequently months. They incur a variety of out-of-pocket expenses while the bills, in many cases, pile up back home. Our support enables many families to extend their stay at the bedside of their wounded loved one.

With the dedicated volunteer board of directors, most of whom have served in the military, we are able to ensure that 100% of donations and the net proceeds from our events is disbursed to these deserving caregiving families.

Tournament Rules, Scoring and Format

- Playing 4-person "Captain's Choice". All players tee-off with captain selecting the best ball location from which play is to continue. All players hit from the selected location. This process continues until the ball is in the hole.
- Once the ball is holed, the number of strokes for that ball is to be recorded.
- Gentlemen play from the **BLUE TEES**, over 60 from the **WHITE TEES**, and over 75 from the **RED TEES**.
- Ladies play from the **RED TEES**
- **Hole-In-One Rules** (Hole #7 and Hole #11)
There are **two tees** for each hole. **All men** play from **165 yards** and **all women** play from **150 yards**.
- If you are 1 player short in your foursome, we will play alternating shots.
- You may lift, clean, and place ball one club length from the original ball position:
 - no closer to the hole
 - not out of rough to fairway
 - not out of sand trap
 - (place ball - does not have to dropped)
- Mulligans consist of a maximum of 8 per team or 2 per player. Cost is \$20 for 2 mulligans and includes 4 blue raffle tickets.
- The top 3 teams will be awarded team prizes. In the event of a tie, the No. 1 handicap hole will be used as the tie breaker.
- There is 1 Longest Drive Contest for Men and Ladies (Hole #5).
- There are 3 Closest-to-Pin Contests: Everyone (Hole #15), Men (Hole #3), and Ladies (Hole #11).
- There is a Beat the Pro Contest (Hole #3).
- PAR is the highest score that can be recorded by your team - so pick up if you are going to make par so that we can keep up our pace of play.
- At end of play, return all carts and scorecards to awards dinner area.
- Most importantly, have fun!
