1st Lt. Jason Mann served in the Marine Corps as an Arab linguist, reconnaissance professional and ground intelligence officer. After attending the Basic Officer Course, he reported to 1st Battalion, 6th Marines for duty as the Battalion's assistant intelligence officer and later, the Battalion's scout sniper platoon commander. On July 17, 2008, in Helmand Province, Afghanistan, he made the ultimate sacrifice for his beloved family, Corps, and country.
