# Tournament Rules, Scoring and Format

- Playing 4-person "Captain's Choice". All players tee-off with captain selecting the best ball location from which play is to continue. All players hit from the selected location. This process continues until the ball is in the hole.
- Once the ball is holed, the number of strokes for that ball is to be recorded.
- Gentlemen play from the **BLUE TEES**, over 60 from the **WHITE TEES**, and over 75 from the **RED TEES**.
- Ladies play from the RED TEES
- Hole-In-One Rules (Hole #7 and Hole #11)
   There are two tees for each hole. All men play from 165 yards and all women play from 150 yards.
- If you are 1 player short in your foursome, we will play alternating shots.
- You may lift, clean, and place ball one club length from the original ball position:
  - no closer to the hole
  - not out of rough to fairway
  - not out of sand trap
  - (place ball does not have to dropped)
- Mulligans consist of a maximum of 8 per team or 2 per player.
   Cost is \$20 for 2 mulligans and includes 4 blue raffle tickets.
- The top 3 teams will be awarded team prizes. In the event of a tie, the No. 1 handicap hole will be used as the tie breaker.
- There is 1 Longest Drive Contest for Men and Ladies (Hole #5).
- There are 3 Closest-to-Pin Contests:
   Men (Hole #3), Ladies (Hole #11), and Everyone (Hole #15)
- There is a Beat the Pro Contest (Hole #3).
- PAR is the highest score that can be recorded by your team so pick up if you are going to make par so that we can keep up our pace of play.
- At end of play, return all carts and scorecards to awards dinner area.
- Most importantly, have fun!


